



HOW TO TAKE OFF THE BANDAGE

After the procedure, the donor area is covered with Vaseline, where it acts as an extra barrier against dirt. We then put a bandage over the donor area.



The day after the procedure, the bandage should be taken off. It is important that it does not stay on for longer than 24 hours or the bandage may dry into the skin.



When you have taken off the bandage, pat the skin dry with a paper towel or use a clean towel. You can wash or shower the donor area if you want.
